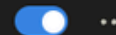

Description 

Digitize tariff document PDFs into structured Excel spreadsheets. Use this skill whenever the user uploads a tariff PDF, tariff schedule, customs duty document, harmonized tariff schedule (HTS/HTSUS), trade regulation PDF, or any PDF containing tariff rate tables, duty rates, or customs classification data. Also trigger when the user mentions 'tariff digitization', 'tariff table extraction', 'convert tariff PDF', 'tariff spreadsheet', or asks to turn a tariff document into a downloadable Excel file. This skill handles scanned and text-based tariff PDFs alike.



Tariff Document Digitizer

Convert tariff document PDFs into clean, structured Excel (.xlsx) files by extracting and reconstructing the tables they contain.

Training Data

Before starting any extraction, read the bundled training data to understand the expected output format:

- `references/training_data.csv` — A clean, pre-parsed CSV containing 116 rows of correctly extracted tariff data. This is your ground truth for what the output should look like.
- `references/training_data.pdf` — The original source PDF that the CSV was extracted from. Use this to understand the kinds of layouts you'll encounter.
